When? 11 a.m. on Sundays

Where? In the Magnolia Building, 414 S. Magnolia, Hyde Park United Methodist Church.

Dress code? Come as you are. Be comfortable in whatever you would like to wear.

Who will be preaching? The Rev. Matt Horan, Associate Pastor, will be the primary preacher with the ongoing participation of the pastoral staff, as well as other ordained and lay speakers occasionally.

Will the "message" match the other services? Yes. The 11 Magnolia service will follow the thematic structure and biblical message of the church.

What style of music will this service utilize? The music will be a variety of contemporary music styles, predominantly familiar Christian contemporary songs that promote participation by the congregation. However, on any given week, there may be acoustic sessions, rock, world beat music, and additional variety.

Is it a youth service? Youth are welcome to worship in this service; however, it is not a youth service specifically. Adults and children of all ages are welcome to worship in this service.

Does this service offer childcare? Yes. Childcare will be integrated into existing children's and youth ministries.

Describe the worship experience. Worship in this casual, comfortable setting with interactive and creative expressions of worship and a variety of contemporary music styles. Enjoy coffee, refreshments and fellowship in a welcoming environment.
